



THE PWC PLAYERS SENIOR OPEN 2017

GENERAL INFORMATION



1. ARRIVAL – FRIDAY 3 FEBRUARY 2017 (or as you planned it).

- Entrance at Sun City – proceed to Gate 6, your name will be on a list and you will be allowed in at NO cost.
- For those residing at Sun City please take note that check-in time officially is 14h00 on the day of arrival.
- Please note that all accommodation arrangements are between yourselves and Sun City and fall outside the scope of the organisers' responsibility

2. PRACTISE ROUND

- The draw for the practise round for **Friday ,3 February 2017** will be available on this website.
- The cost of the practise round is **R550** which includes halfway lunch . The caddie fee is **R200**, excluding tip, and the caddie foundation fee of **R25** must be paid in the Pro Shop before teeing off. **These costs are for your own account.**
- Please note that it is **not compulsory** to take a caddy for the practise round or during the tournament proper. Trolleys will be allowed. Outside caddies will not be permitted, not even to pull a trolley.
- Please note that Gary Player Country Club is a **no cart** course.

3 . REGISTRATION

- The registration for The PWC Players will take place on Friday, 3 February 2017 from 18H00 onwards, or on Saturday morning from 07H00 onwards at the clubhouse area of Gary Player CC.
- Please make sure that your cell number is correct as this will be the way of communication with all players.

4. DRESS CODE

- Short pants will be allowed.
- Only recognised golf attire with soft spikes must be worn.

5. DRIVING RANGE

- There is no driving range at GPCC, but the range facilities will be available at The Lost City driving range.

6. MEASURING DEVICES

- Distance measuring devices will be allowed provided only direct distance functions are used.
- Distances are measured to the middle of the green.
- Pin sheets will be available for each day.

7. SATURDAY – 4 FEBRUARY 2017

- Tee times for Saturday will be from 08h00 to 12h30 in three balls with 8 minute intervals from the first tee.
- Apart from the putting and chipping green next to the clubhouse, you may also make use of the new putting green next to the first tee before you start play.
- The draw for day 1 is a random draw whilst day 2 will have a seeded draw. The draw for day 1 will be available on this website.
- We will be playing from the GREEN markers.
- After completion of your round at the 18th green, golf carts will transport you back to the Country Club.
- The format will be stroke play over 36 holes.
- For the course layout please visit the website of the Gary Player CC.

8. SUNDAY – 5 FEBRUARY 2016

- Tee times from 08h00 to 10h08 in three balls with 8 minute intervals from both tees.
- Seeded according to the first round gross results.
- Prize giving will take place after play on Sunday in the clubhouse area at the Pro Shop at approximately 15h00. Prize winners not in attendance will forfeit their prizes.

9. SCORING

- Scoring will be done by Rinus van Niekerk and he will also act as the rules official at the scoring table.
- For any queries that cannot be resolved on course, please play two balls and resolve the issue at the scoring table, even if the scores were the same with both balls.
- Please hand in your scorecards at the table near the Pro Shop immediately on completion of your round!

10. PLAY-OFF.

- In the case of a tie for the first prize only, the winner will be determined by a sudden death play-off on holes 1 and 9 repetitively until a winner emerges.
- For all other ties a count out procedure will be followed. The scores over the last round, then the last nine holes of the last round, then the last six holes, the last three holes and finally from hole 18 backwards until the tie is broken will be taken.

11. COSTS FOR THE PLAYERS

The following costs are covered as part of the tournament:

- Entrance to the resort. Just mention that you participate in the tournament.
- The green fees for the two rounds on Saturday and Sunday.
- Halfway voucher for the two days. As you approach the ninth green you can place your order with the waiter and when finishing the hole your order will be waiting for you at the halfway house. Maximum time allowed 15 min please!

The following costs are not covered and are for the account of the player:

- Green fees (which include halfway) for the practise round on Friday.
- Caddie fees (R200+R25=R225 per round) for all the rounds.
- All accommodation.
- All other incidental costs that are incurred.

12. FINAL LOCAL RULES
